COUNSELLING TRAINING

The counselling profession is self-regulating which results in many courses being advertised at various levels and different costs. This variety even extends to online courses.

It's important to remember that Levels ascribed to other types of vocational courses may not always equate to counselling training. This can make it difficult for you to choose the best course. It is more reliable to choose a counselling course based on number of hours studied and the organisations which accredit or quality check courses. All Iron Mill courses are accredited, or quality checked.



The Iron Mill offers an integrative model of counselling which provides students learning opportunities in a wide range of different theories, topics and practice. An integrative approach has become increasingly popular because of the wide range of problems and personalities that present in counselling.



PSYCHOTHERAPY TRAINING

The main professional body for psychotherapists in this country is the UK Council for Psychotherapy (UKCP). They set out Standards of Education and Training for the psychotherapy training courses that they Accredit. These psychotherapy courses are all at least 4 years long, and at Postgraduate level (these are requirements of the UKCP).

At the Iron Mill, the Integrative and Relational Psychotherapy programme is accredited by UKCP. The programme is grounded in Relational Transactional Analysis and the training is recognised by International TA organisations. The programme is designed to lead to qualification as a UK based psychotherapist.

Transactional analysis is an integrative modality, with a depth of theory that has been developed over 60 years and continues to evolve. Because of this, the theoretical concepts link well together and inform thinking about each other and clinical practice. It is an extremely robust theory that allows the psychotherapist to remain grounded, even when working with very complex problems.

Course Description

The Counselling Skills weekend certificate has been developed for students who wish to apply for the Iron Mill advanced courses but have completed their certificate in counselling online, with a tutor. As advanced courses require face-to-face counselling skills experience, the College doesn't accept online only certificates. This weekend certificate provides the additional experience needed and upon successful completion, candidates may make application to the advanced courses, subject to other criteria being met.

There is a such a plethora of online counselling courses, of varying content, depth and hours of study, that we advise you to contact us to check your eligibility for this top up weekend.

Learning Outcomes

At the heart of the Counselling Skills Weekend Certificate are five overarching educational aims. These are that the course will:

- Encourage and provide opportunities for the development of basic counselling skills;
- Enhance student self-awareness and reflective skills;
- Encourage awareness of difference and diversity;
- Facilitate group participation
- Encourage the use of self-reflection

Entry Requirements

A Level 2 or Level 3 Certificate where counselling skills component was delivered online.



TA 101 OFFICIAL INTRODUCTION TO TRANSACTIONAL ANALYSIS

Course description

This in person course, delivered over 2-days, will be of interest to anyone wanting to learn about the key concepts and theories of Transactional Analysis (TA), as a way of understanding what makes people tick.

A stand-alone course, with a standardised syllabus agreed by international TA organisations, recognised by the European Association of Transactional Analysis (EATA) and the International Transactional Analysis Association (ITAA). Participants will be awarded an officially recognised TA 101 certificate upon completion.

TA theory provides ways of looking at ourselves and our relationships, as a way of understanding the ways we communicate and the repeating patterns we get into. It can be applied in counselling and psychotherapy, in organisations and in education.

TA is a social psychology with a depth of theory on: Personality - how people are structured psychologically and the impact this has on their thinking, feeling and behaviour; Communication - how we interact (transact) with one another and within organisations; and Human Development – how, through interactions with individuals and our environment, our personality develops through childhood and later.

Explores the concepts of Ego States, Transactions, Psychological Games, Life Scripts and more. Uses examples from daily life and simple group exercises, allowing participants to discuss how they can use TA theory to think about themselves and their interactions with others.

This is the pre-requisite for those who wish to go on to study TA at an advanced level.

Course Description

This training offers an exciting opportunity to explore the fundamental theories and concepts of Transactional Analysis (TA) and their relevance to personal life, decisions, and relationships. It is the essential foundation year for future study. This year is also valuable for anyone seeking personal growth and development. It can be transformative in terms of self-discovery, giving a deeper understanding of personality, choices and your personal relationships.

The course runs for 9 weekends from October to June during which you'll deepen your understanding of a wide array of TA theories and approaches as well as learning practical counselling skills from our tutors. Our tutors are highly experienced Transactional Analysis psychotherapists, supervisors and trainers. They are committed to providing creative learning experiences that are based on the experiences and needs of the learning group.

Entry Requirements

There is no specific qualification or experience required, though there is an assessment process via written statement, online application form and an in person or online interview. This is to assess personal and professional readiness to do this training. Consideration is given to the academic, financial and emotional demands this training will have. It is positioned at equivalent to a level 5. To complete the year and gain the certificate, you will need to complete a TA 101 and it is recommended that you do this first if possible.

Progression

The next stage is the Advanced Diploma in Integrative Psychotherapy (Relational TA) Course which can lead to qualifying as a UKCP-Registered psychotherapist and as a Certified Transactional Analysts with a specialism in psychotherapy.

ADVANCED DIPLOMA IN INTEGRATIVE PSYCHOTHERAPY (RELATIONAL TA)

Course description

The aim of this course is to provide comprehensive training in Transactional Analysis psychotherapy. This is a thorough, integrated and relational approach to psychotherapy, which includes the depth and breadth required to meet national training requirements and build knowledge and experience as a practitioner.

Relational psychotherapy aims to allow clients to change in profound ways, to improve their lives, their relational patterns and ways of being in the world. It allows the psychotherapist and client to work in depth, in the long term, with complex psychological problems, including some serious mental illnesses. It has models that provide structure and can describe and shed light on important conscious and non-conscious processes. The theory can be used for reflection and to provide direction for the work.

This is a four year course comprising three years teaching, followed by a dissertation year which leads to the final qualifications. For the first three years, the programme runs between September and July for 10 weekends in total.

Entry Requirements

You will need to have successfully completed the Iron Mill Certificate in Transactional Analysis Theory and Practice (CTAP). If you have studied a TA Foundation course at another TA institute (training to have been in person), we would need a reference confirming that you have been approved to start client work. You will also be required to attend for interview.

Progression

Students are prepared for working as psychotherapists in a variety of settings and (through the qualification process), gain UKCP Registration as a psychotherapist.

Our Post Qualifying Diploma in Counselling Young People (8-18 years) addresses the majority of the BACP Competences for Humanistic Counselling with children and young people. The Diploma focuses on work with young people and centres on the 8-18 year age group.

It is designed for those counselling practitioners who are post-qualified but who need further specialist training to enable them to work competently with young people. The objectives of the course are to:

- provide a sound working knowledge of the ethical, professional and legal frameworks relevant to young people.
- develop your understanding of family development and how external environment interacts with child and adolescent development.
- enable you to develop further the theory and principles underpinning your practice and apply your existing knowledge of and competence in working in therapeutic relationships within the context of counselling.
- build on your working knowledge of mental health difficulties, well-being and pharmacology.
- develop your competence to work with the whole person.

Entry Requirements

You should be a qualified, practising counsellor or psychotherapist, working within a recognised professional code of ethics. A member of a relevant professional body like the British Association for Counselling and Psychotherapy (BACP), National Counselling & Psychotherapy Society (NCPS) or the UK Council for Psychotherapy (UKCP) and hold current professional indemnity insurance that covers your work as a practising counsellor or psychotherapist.
